- Welcome and Call to Order – Brandon Long
  - Approval of December minutes
    - 1 Motion to Approve December minutes – Michael Palumbo
    - 11 2<sup>nd</sup> – Deja Mitchell
- First Friday Art Stroll - Update – All
  - Overall the art stroll was not as busy, maybe due to the cold
  - Eccles had a good turnout for their high school showcase, it will be up all month
  - The Argo House was busier at the beginning, Daryl's art will continue be up through March with some updated pieces
  - DaVinci Academy had a lot of foot traffic for their big student showcase
  - Van Sessions had a good crowd for their first indoor podcast at The Monarch
- Arts on the Town Pre-Planning - Lorie Buckley
  - Lorie gave a tentative date of April 25, 2019, location still to be determined Russ offered his location as a possible venue for the event
  - She is looking for suggestions on how to make the event a social one but also structured
  - It was suggested that maybe have 1-2 presentations from grantees about their unique projects
- Public Art – Lorie Buckley
  - The rankings are now with the Economic and Development department It will go to the Director's meeting and to City Council Lorie is hoping that the timeline will somehow coincide with the ordinance change

- The Nine Rails Projects is done and each person is under contract There are five new projects starting soon

  - Arts Grants open January 14, 2019 The grant workshops are on January 31 at noon and 6 30 p m The cycle will close on March 15
  - Lorie is working on Ramp Grants that are due January 18<sup>th</sup> and the local Arts Agency Grants on February 15

  - We are in need of two people total to join the Arts Committee to fill the open spots One for the Literary and Theater seat We have received two recommendations and Lorie will email their information out to everyone so they can vote

- Committee Blog – Regina Esparza
  - Everyone has been submitting theirs with a few holes due to the holiday and members no longer with us
  - The Standard-Examiner is not responding to our emails about the blog The city site will post the blogs once it is updated Scott Patria said he might be able to add the blogs to the O1 Arts Newsletter if it does not have a time constraint There is no date yet for the Nine Rails website finalization, so we can have the blogs posted
  - Per Lorie, as of today we will put a stop to the blogs until we have something more concrete where the blogs can be posted
  
- Update from Diversity Commission – Taylor
  - The Diversity Commission is also looking for recommendations for two spots that are open due to terms ending for commission members
  - They have their meeting tomorrow
  - There will be a career fair coming up soon to offer east central/ minority communities an opportunity Taylor asked if anyone is looking to hire someone to contact him
  - He mentioned that students from Weber State University did a study on communication about reaching the community The class will be working on following up on their findings and seeing what other options are available They will also present it to City Council


- *Nestor* – Winter Market is starting up on January 19 and O-town Kitchen will have a booth
  - *Jess* – Tomorrow is the VIP Town Hall meeting at 9 a.m. at the Bigelow for an hour 10 a.m. they will have the Spike 150 Special presentation. The Winter Market will run from January 19 to February 23. There will be live music, yoga and other fun stuff happening. There are 52 vendors working from 9 a.m. – 2 p.m. The Junior League will have performances Feb 7, 8, 9 of The Vagina Monologues. Nine Rails will have their meeting February 19 at noon at the Weber County Library. As for the New Year's Eve celebration, they had under 200 in attendance, the food was delicious, and they also received positive feedback and are thinking about what to plan for next year.
  - *Russ* – Ogden UnCon will have a booth up at Yeti Bash to pass out fliers. He will be making a guest appearance in Texas at another smaller convention. It has not been officially announced by Hansen Robotics has a mini version of Sofia. There are exclusive items that will be given away in conjunction with event coming up in June.


