1. What is the Total storage requirement before RAID?

a. The Storage Requirements for this are:

QTY 1 - Boot Optimized Storage Cards	BOSS controller card + with 2 M.2 Sticks 240G (RAID 1),LP

2. Would you please clarify a few questions below for this Dell PowerEdge Servers RFB?

a. Intel Xeon Gold 6248R 3.0G, 24C/48T, 10.4GT/s, 35.75M 2933 (2)"

i. For the Intel Xeon processor, is it QTY (2)?

1. Yes Quantity 2 of the Processors for each server.

b. "1U Pipe Low Profile Heatsink (2)" - Is the QTY (2) for the 1U Pipe Low Profile Heatsink?

i. Yes, Quantity of 2 of the same heatsink for those Processors.

c. "16GB RDIMM, 3200MT/s, Dual Rank" - Is the request for Dual 16 GB for 32 GB total, or Dual 8 GB to make 16 GB total?
