Q & A

- 1) *Are we supposed to provide the L-Bracket and if yes, what color?*
 - a) Yes, this should be included in your bid. The L-bracket (or corner bracket) should be in color black.
- 2) *Regarding the stone, do we just provide a bid as close as we can get to the one used here at 22nd Trailhead?*
 - a) Yes, if you can provide an alternative or line item to break out natural stone versus cultured stone, that would help us in deciding.
- 3) *Are we mimicking this sign at the 22nd Trailhead?*
 - a) Yes, we want to standardize as much as possible. However, there are certain site conditions, etc. that need to be taken into consideration, measurements may vary between the two sites, Gib's Loop Trailhead at Mt. Ogden Park & West Stadium Park.
 - b) Field-fit – If variations from the specs need to occur, the City will need to sign off on it.
- 4) *Do you require rebar in the footing?*
 - a) Yes, please specify the size included in your bid.
- 5) *Is there going to be inspection and at what point?*
 - a) Parks will double-check records but there is an anticipated inspection for the footing.
- 6) *Gib's Loop Trailhead – Replace existing signage.*
- 7) *West Stadium Park – Boulders and bigger rocks are to stay at the site; remove other items to make area clean.*

8) *Additional Notes:*

- a) In your bid, specify the timber to be used.
- b) Parks division will order Blue staking to mark the final placement of the signs.
- c) Parks will work with the successful contractor to get permits.
- d) Work Schedule – Coordinate in advance with Parks division the dates and time of work hours to get public information / notice out ahead of schedule.
- e) Maintain a safe work zone.
