Affordable flights from Ogden to Burbank

Ogden-Hinckley Airport is excited to announce that Avelo Airlines have begun flight service from Ogden, Utah to Burbank, California, that began May 4th, 2021.

Avelo Airlines flight XP 108 departs OGD at 2:40 p.m., arriving in BUR at 3:40 p.m. local time. The route will be served by 189-seat Boeing 737-800 aircraft – one of the most fuel-efficient commercial aircraft in the world – providing customers with a large, comfortable cabin with more room, more seats, and more seating options than typical regional aircraft.

Expanding commercial air service out of the Ogden-Hinckley Airport is a key component of the airport's long-term plan as well as the City's economic development strategy. Ogden City Water in Short Supply

Ogden City receives water from both surface and underground sources.

This past winter provided below-average snowpack, and the result is that Ogden City will face a water shortage in 2021. To provide adequate resources for life-essential processes, city residents must implement water conservation practices. Ogden City residents are encouraged to reduce their water use by 5%.

The most significant use of water among residential properties is landscape irrigation. It is possible to maintain an attractive landscape while using less water. The key is to provide irrigation water only when necessary and in the most efficient manner. An efficient irrigation system will provide uniform distribution with minimal overspray and drift onto non-irrigable surfaces. To help residents achieve an efficient irrigation system, Ogden City provides a free water audit program. The program consists of several field tests that address irrigation system deficiencies. The audit also provides a suggested irrigation schedule. Residents can call in or schedule an appointment online.

Water conservation is a group effort. While individual actions may not seem to amount to significant savings, the compound effect can have a considerable impact. In conservation, the following mantra holds water: "Every drop counts!"

Firework Safety This Summer

The Ogden City Fire Department encourages you to enjoy fireworks responsibly this holiday season.

Remember that consumer fireworks can be dangerous, potentially resulting in injured persons and damaged property.

We ask that Ogden City residents follow some common-sense guidelines when using fireworks:

- Follow label instructions and have an adult present
- Never point or throw fireworks at another person
- Use fireworks only outdoors in a clear area at least 20-30 feet
- Never carry fireworks in your pocket or shoot them in a metal or glass container
- Light one item at a time and then move back quickly
- Keep a bucket of water or garden hose ready
- Fireworks may be discharged from July 2nd to July 5th, and July 22nd to July 25th

Remember that only fireworks for sale in Utah are legal in Ogden City. During summer, conditions are monitored, and fireworks may be banned in certain areas due to drought.
