**One (1) New ADA Compliant Passenger Boarding Ramp  
for the Ogden Regional Airport**

**Q & A**

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*Q - I am currently working on the bid for the ADA-Compliant Passenger Boarding Ramp for the Ogden Regional Airport and hoping to have a question or two resolved regarding the specifications for the design of this project. In researching the code requirements for ADA compliance, I have found that there are several different specifications and wanted to clear up which requirement is desired to be followed. According to the slope requirements, for vertical travel exceeding 0.5 inches, unassisted access the slope of the ramp is not to exceed 1 vertical foot for every 12 horizontal feet; for unassisted access for 5 ft of travel, slope of the ramp is not to exceed 1 vertical foot for every 8 horizontal feet; and for assisted access slope is not to exceed 1 vertical foot for every 4 horizontal feet. The specifications set in the document provided to me is rather sparse concerning which requirement designation is to be followed and would greatly impact overall design. If possible, could you please indicate which requirement needs to be used?*

A - We are looking for a product that has already been designed and has been sold to at least three airports that you would be required to provide references for.

ADA is met with human assistance to push the wheelchair up the ramp to the door of the aircraft. I cannot provide you with the detailed information from the other competitors, but I am certain that you can search the internet and see similar products that are for sale.
