 - b. Prohibiting Painted Brick in Certain East Central Zones. (Presentation) Proposed Ordinance 2021-61 amending sections 15-15-2.B, 15-35-5.B, and 15-36-5.B of the Municipal Code to allow brick homes to be painted in the East Central Single-Family Residential Zone (R-1-5), Two-Family Residential Zone (R-2EC), and Multi-Family Residential Zone (R-3). (Input received; ordinance adopted, vote: 7-0)
