## Youth Show

### ELIGIBILITY

Community Art Show is looking for artists 17 and under who work with any medium. Two- and Three-Dimensional works will be accepted. Literary artists may also submit poetry or written word works for display. Written works must fit onto one displayable page. Show is open to all artists up to 17 years old, or any or skill level who presently reside in the state of Utah. Original works in any medium are eligible. REPRODUCTIONS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE.

Work must have been completed within the past two years. Artists are limited to three entries. Maximum surface size is 60" x 60". Large scale sculpture pieces must be able to stand alone and be stable on the floor.

Entries must be ready to display. If the piece needs to be displayed in a hanging position, it must be mounted, matted and or framed, or otherwise ready to display in exhibition condition. Wire hanging system installed on hanging artwork is required.

Works must be presented in a manner that is acceptable for public viewing of all ages. Works that may be offensive, derogatory, or pornographic will not be accepted.

## **ENTRY PROCESS**

There is no entry fee to participate in Community Art Show.

Entries will take place via an online submission at: [ogdencity.com/artistcall](http://ogdencity.com/artistcall)

A short artist statement will be requested for all entries and will be displayed with the artwork if artist/artwork is selected for the show.

Artists that are selected to participate in the show will be contacted using the email address provided on the entry form. A drop off date will be provided to artists in that communication.

Jury Selected entries delivered for display must be clearly identified by the artist with title, medium and price/insurance value. Identification tags will be provided at the time of selection notification via email.

## **LIABILITY**

Every reasonable precaution will be taken to protect work submitted. Work left at the Union Station after the show is deinstalled are left at artist's own risk and storage charges may accrue. Artist is responsible to deliver and pick up works within the directed timeline. Works left at the Union Station for over 30 days will be deemed abandoned and disposed of at the staff's discretion. Community Art Show does not accept responsibility for works damaged due to incorrect or poor framing, poor hanging systems, or poor preparation for display. Three-dimensional works should be submitted that are not wobbly, or unstable for public display. Remember this venue is open to the general public for viewing.

## **ARTIST HONORARIUMS**

Artist honorariums are paid by Ogden City Arts.

Prizes will be awarded to selected artworks.

## **OPENING RECEPTION, & EXHIBIT TIME**

A reception for artists, friends and the community will be held on Wednesday, March 9, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. in the Union Station. Awards will be announced at the reception.

## **ARTWORK PICKUP-**

At the show's conclusion participating artists will be directed to pick their artwork during Union Station hours from May 19-21, 2022. (this window of time is subject to change)

\* Works left at the Union Station for over 30 days will be deemed abandoned and disposed of at the staff's discretion. Artists may also be liable for storage charges.
