

TSA REQUIRED 100% OGD AIRPORT BADGE AUDIT BEGINNING APRIL 1, 2022

TSA REQUIRED ANNUAL 100% OGD BADGE HOLDER AUDIT

Like last year, TSA requires that the OGD Airport conduct an audit of 100% of its issued and active badges. The audit process is simple: Just use your proximity badge at any card reader on the OGD Airport security system during the 30-day audit (Friday April 1st, 2022 to Saturday April 30th, 2022).

Place your badge next to the access point card reader, then enter your

Personal Identification Number (PIN), followed by pressing the "#" pound key. Once the door or vehicle gate opens and then closes and secures, you are done!

Unfortunately, if any active badge holder does not do this between April 1st and April 30th, their badge will be deactivated, per TSA requirements, on May 1st. The badge holder who does not participate in the audit and then has their badge deactivated, will have to pay a \$100 penalty before their badge can be reactivated.

Please make every effort to comply with the audit requirements and not wait until the last minute.

Keep in mind that we installed a test reader in the OGD Terminal Building entrance vestibule. Using your badge and PIN on this reader does not open any door or gate. Using this reader just causes the blue light above the badge reader to flash. Once the blue light flashes, you have successfully completed the audit.
