HIGH WIND WARNING

Remember that anything not fastened down can become a projectile that damages someone else's property / aircraft. The time frame could exceed the times listed below.

* WHAT...High Wind Warning from 6 PM this evening until noon Wednesday, east winds 30 to 40 mph with gusts in excess of 65 mph expected.

* WHERE...Northern Wasatch Front, especially the I-15 corridor and the US-89 corridor between Farmington and South Weber.

* WHEN...6 PM this evening to 9 AM MDT Wednesday.

* IMPACTS...High winds may move loose debris, damage property and cause power outages. Travel will be difficult especially for high profile vehicles.

*PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...

People are urged to secure loose objects that could be blown around or damaged by the wind. Secure outdoor furniture, trampolines, farm equipment, and other objects that may become airborne in strong winds. Strong crosswinds are expected on north to south running routes including I-15, US-89, and the Legacy Parkway.
