**Q & A**

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1. Per page 11, RFP states "Bids shall remain firm from the date of award through January 1, 2026". Can you please confirm that the first-year pricing is firm and the 2 consecutive years following may be approved if sufficient supporting documentation is provided which demonstrates mathematically why the change is requested? **This is correct, on an annual basis the product pricing can be adjusted (if agreed upon by both parties). Reference must be made to the increase in production or service cost.**
2. In addition to the above question, the RFP states contract is a 3-year contract but also states it can be renewed for an additional 2 years. Can you confirm that the 2 year renewal is after the first year of firm pricing? **The 2 year renewal would be negotiated once the original 3 year agreement is set to expired. Basically the 3 year agreement is set to expire. Ogden Fire could request to extend the agreement for 1 year and an addendum would be added to the contact. This process could occur twice for a total of 5 years before a new RFP is established.**
3. Per the turnout coat and pant specifications, the RFP requests 3" comfort trim, which is heat applied and does not use any stitching. However, there is a separate section that requests reinforced trim stitching to be used for trim. Please clarify which trim is requested for this spec. **Ogden would prefer stitched trim but will consider trim that is heat applied if this is your product standard.**  
**The concern is that we do not want the trim to peel off.**
