**REPORT TO JOINT REPORTING COMMITTEE**

A bidder must indicate whether he has previously had a contract subject to the equal opportunity clause, whether he has filed all report forms required in such contract, and if not, a compliance report (Standard Form (SF) 100) must be submitted with his bid.

Any Contractor having a Federal or Federally assisted contract of \$50,000 or more and 50 or more employees is required to file annual compliance reports on Standard Form 100 (EEO-1) with the Joint Reporting Committee in accordance with the instructions provided with the form. The Contractor will provide a copy of such a report to the contracting agency within 30 days after the award of a contract if he has not submitted a complete compliance report within 12 months preceding the date of the award.
